# PATHWAYS TO RECOVERY

In 2003 Detroit applied for and received a CSAT Recovery Community Support Program (RCSP) Grant.

This grant provided the impetus for us to begin transforming our system from a traditional treatment centered approach to a recovery centered approach.

# PATHWAYS TO RECOVERY

## KEY ELEMENTS OF A RECOVERY - ORIENTED SYSTEM OF CARE

- ROSC's offers a comprehensive menu of services and supports that can be combined and readily adjusted to meet the individual's needs and chosen pathways to recovery.
- ROSC's encompass and coordinates the operation of multiple systems, providing responsive, outcome-driven approaches to care.

# PATHWAYS TO RECOVERY

- Recovery services should be available to all irrespective of the pathway they select.
- The individual must be the principal developer of their recovery plan.
- Recovery support must be available continuously.

# PATHWAYS TO RECOVERY

A major focus of a Recovery Oriented System of Care is to create the physical, psychological, and social space within local communities in which recovery can flourish.

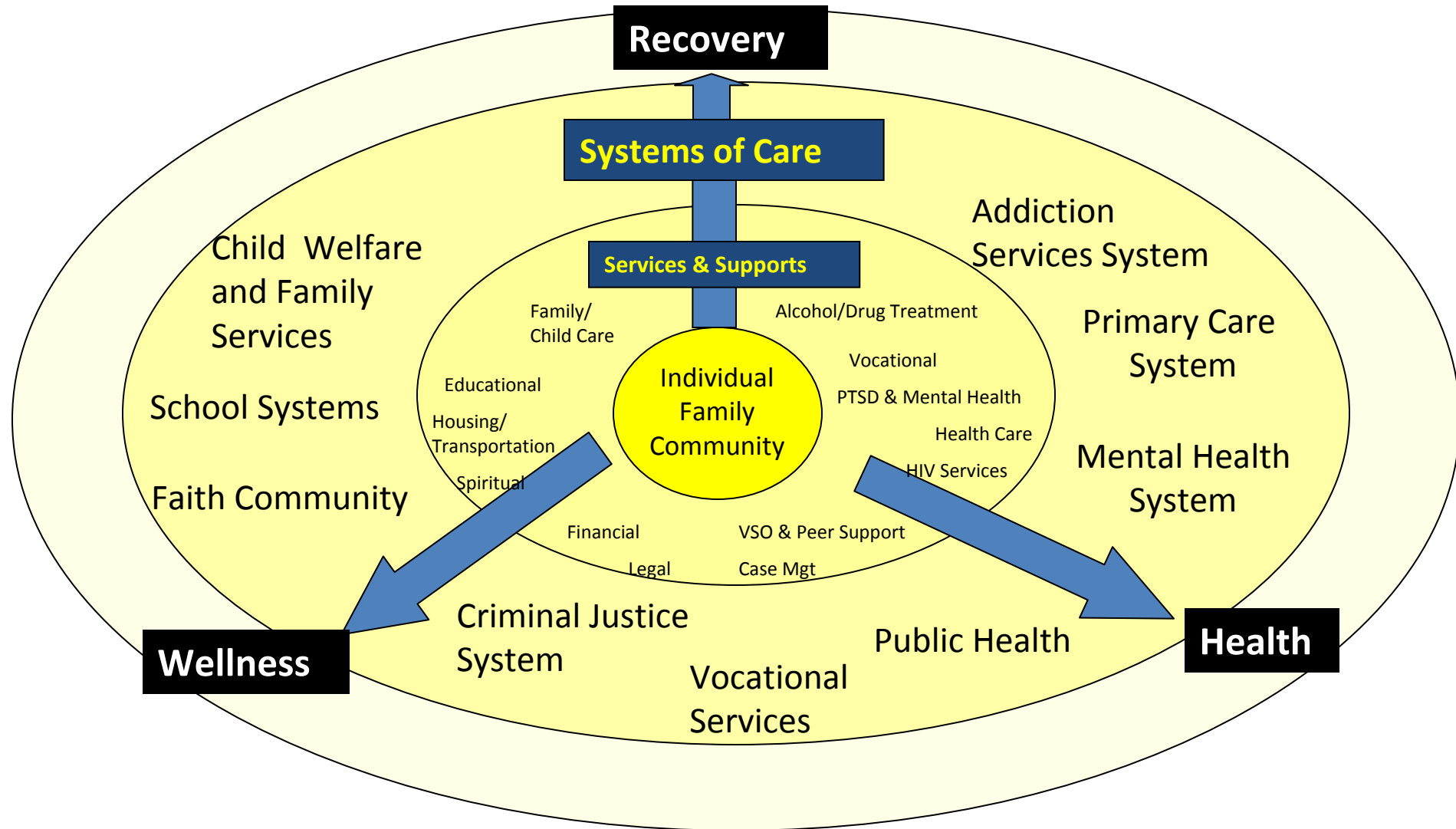
The ultimate goal is not to create larger treatment organizations, but to expand each community's natural recovery support resources.

- Sponsor annual city-wide Faith Conference focusing on substance abuse (3000 participants in 2008)
